**Limited Term Appointments**

Dalhousie University School of Nursing is undergoing an exciting and transformative expansion and is seeking outstanding educators and practitioners for three full-time, two-year, limited term positions at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor. Appointments will be effective **August 1, 2010**.

The primary responsibilities of successful candidates will be teaching and supervision of undergraduate students including tutorial, laboratory, and clinical teaching during fall, winter and/or summer terms. Expertise in adult, mental health, maternal-child/family, and/or community health nursing is of particular interest. Additionally, a background in ethics, genetics, diversity in healthcare, information technology, interprofessional/interdisciplinary education, innovative teaching and technology, including distance and context-based learning, and/or clinical simulation, would be an asset.

A doctoral degree is preferred; a graduate degree in nursing is required. Qualified candidates must have a minimum of two years of recent clinical practice, and clinical teaching experience, and must be eligible for registration as a nurse/nurse practitioner with the College of Registered Nurses of Nova Scotia ([www.crnns.ca](http://www.crnns.ca)). Self-directedness, and the ability work collaboratively, are essential.

A complete application is comprised of the following:

- A cover letter stating your qualifications, expertise, and evidence of teaching effectiveness;
- A copy of your curriculum vitae;
- Evidence of your clinical practice and clinical teaching experience;
- Evidence of your eligibility for registration as a nurse/nurse practitioner with the College of Registered Nurses of Nova Scotia; and,
- Three confidential letters of reference, including one from your most recent employer, forwarded under separate cover directly from your referees
