These positions are expected to provide nursing and dietary care for diabetes clients within a holistic, interdisciplinary team-based approach to health care.

Key areas of responsibility include planning and coordinating care, case management, maintaining electronic client records, and delivering culturally appropriate education about diabetes care and prevention. Extensive travel to communities throughout the catchment area is required.

- current registration with CNO or CDO and certified or eligible for certification as a Certified Diabetes Educator;
- experience working with Aboriginal people and communities, and demonstrated understanding of Aboriginal culture, values and perspectives;
- ability to speak and understand Ojibwe an asset (to communicate with and/or interpret for client group) is a definite asset;

- commitment to ongoing training and professional development relevant to job requirements;
